### **International Day**

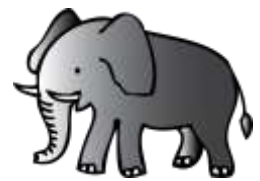
We are joining Ark Priory for an International day on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June. It is a chance to celebrate the diversity within our school.
