Our Learning This Week

Our focus for learning this week has been the Little Red Hen story. The children have been acting this out and writing their own story into a book.

On Monday we had an exciting delivery of eggs with an incubator. The children encouraged the chicks to hatch by using cheeping sounds on the iPad. All the eggs hatched and the chicks are now in brood boxes in both classrooms. Please see the pictures below.

In Maths children have continued to work with coins. They have been making amounts in different ways (e.g. two 5ps or five 2ps making 10p) and starting to learn about giving change. Please talk to your child about the coins you use when shopping and help them to make amounts in different ways.
