- Identify shapes by the number of vertices and sides.
- Identify right angles in shapes.
- Recognise lines of symmetry in 2D shapes.
- Describe and sort 2D shapes according to their properties.
- To recognise the place value of each digit in a 3-digit number.
- To compare numbers within 1000 using $<$, $>$ and $=$.
- To accurately read scales within 1000 units.
